Multi-award-winning British saxophonist and composer Emma Rawicz emerged on the international stage to critical acclaim at the age of just 21, with her first release on the ACT label. She has made her debut on Europe's most important stages and festival lineups, including Ronnie Scott's, Cadogan Hall, the Berlin Philharmonie, the Transition Festival, the Burghausen Jazz Festival, the Love Supreme Festival and more. She was the youngest ever Artist in Residence at the Cambridge Jazz Festival and has received several awards and nominations in recognition of her achievements. She has also been named BBC New Generation Artist from September 2024 for two years. In the past year alone, she gave over 70 shows across 16 countries as bandleader and featured artist. The release of her album «CHROMA» in 2023 marked a major step forward for Emma Rawicz as a player and composer, and it has since grown into a project with a distinct identity that provides listeners with a new sound at every concert. Alongside her all-star quartet, she has plans for other projects soon, with her Inkyra groove/fusion sextet, a duo project with pianist Gwilym Simcock (album released in March 2025), and much more, ranging from a classical-jazz-folk string quartet with Elliot Galvin to electrifying jazz orchestral music.
